




- 2003 Rural Law Online Project

You may request the insurer to take the excess out of any payment you will receive. If you will not be receiving any payment, but the insurer will be paying a repairer or someone else on your behalf, you may ask the insurer to make the payment to them and then accept the excess from you in instalments.</li> <li>See the Consumer Credit Legal Centre's Sample Letter, 'Can't pay my excess'.</li> <li>Making the Claim</li> </ul>




