Why Accredit – NHMRC perspective?

- Help create a self-improving regional health system so that regional health services can quickly take advantage of cutting-edge research and that the research agenda can be shaped (and owned) by the needs of end-users, such as health care providers and health care consumers.
 - Encourage leadership and collaboration in health research and translation
 - Promote the development and use of innovative and evidence-based models of health care practices and policies that are of direct relevance and benefit to regional and remote areas

Evaluation Criteria

- Outstanding leadership in research- and research-based clinical care that enhances the quality of health care in regional and remote Australia.
- Excellence in innovative biomedical, clinical, public health and/or health services research addresses the challenges and opportunities of health care provision in regional and remote Australia.
- 3. Programs and activities to **accelerate translation** of research findings into health care and ways of bringing health care problems to the researchers.
- Research-infused education and training.
- 5. Health professional leaders who ensure that research **knowledge is translated** into policies and practices locally, nationally and internationally.
- 6. Strong **collaboration** amongst the research, translation, patient care and education programs.
